

Each December, we celebrate Arbor Day at Mission Trails Regional Park to beautify the park, recognize the importance of trees in our environment, and create more shady areas for Mission Trails' current and future visitors.

THE FALL SEASON PROVIDES THE IDEAL PLANTING CONDITIONS FOR YOUNG TREES. This year, we will plant 10 Coast Live Oak trees on Saturday, December 1 at the Kumeyaay Lake Campground (KLC). We will have an additional 10 trees at our nursery to be planted by MTRP staff as needed.

Whether or not you are able to come to the public planting on December 1, you can support this effort by donating \$100 to sponsor one of the 20 trees. Everyone is invited to the tree planting on Saturday, December 1 at 9AM, meeting at the KLC Day Use Lot. The holes will be pre-dug; gloves and comfortable shoes are recommended.
