APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION: It was moved and seconded (Searcy/MacKenzie) to approve the minutes of the meeting of September 3, 2019. The motion passed unanimously with Boyer, Lipson, and Hutsel abstaining.

CHAIR'S REPORT -

- Rob Hutsel has been officially confirmed as a CAC member representing the County of San Diego Parks and Recreation Committee. Now the only remaining vacant CAC position is the member representing the City of El Cajon.
- The City and the County are currently in negotiations to revise the JEPA. There is a desire from the county to combine the Cowles Mtn. and Tijuana River valley agreements into one document but this desire is not shared by the CAC chair. It has been requested that the agreement comes to the CAC for review prior any formal approvals. A meeting between the CAC Chair and the County Parks and Recreation Director is scheduled for tomorrow. The County is asking that all antenna fund proposals go before the City Council and the County Board of Supervisors and that if there is not agreement on use of the funds then the County would be able to utilize 50% of the fund on projects the County deems appropriate.

RANGERS REPORT -

 All of the peak monuments have been installed. The Education program is back in full swing. The new nest box exhibit has been installed.

103. Criteria for establishing priorities for MTRP MPU implementation.

Jack Zarour, East Elliott property owner, read a prepared statement asking that the CAC recommend that the City "hire KTU&A to re-design a new trail system for the East Elliott Extension

that is not on our properties, and to go through the process and re-submit for approvals from the Planning Commission, Environmental and the City Council." Full statement available on request.

It was moved/seconded (Murphy/Hutsel) to approve the criteria as presented. The motion passed unanimously with Boyer abstaining.

104. Appointment of a CAC ad hoc subcommittee to identify and recommend priorities.

Kevin Loomis, SDMBA, stated that the reason I got involved at MTRP was to help. One of the reasons I really wanted to be a part of the CAC was to be be a part of the MPU implementation process. We are growing and have equipment and want to be a part of the solution. I understand why I can't be on the subcommittee but what I am asking is how can I be a part of the process?

A subcommittee consisting of Murphy, Acevedo, Searcy, Ogilvie, and Hartegan was established with Leonard appointed to chair the subcommittee.

301. MTRP Antenna Fund Report – Steve Haupt, District Manager, Open Space Division, P&R

\$954,500.00 is available and \$960,000.00 has been allocated from the fund for the West Sycamore improvements.

302. Old Mission Dam dredging project - *Steve Haupt, District Manager, Open Space Division, P&R Department*

All the information was submitted to the P&C department in late August. Notification was received today that they would start looking into it shortly. The best case scenario is a 90 day process to award a contract.

303. Mission Trails Field Station project update – *Ryan Robertson, Senior Park Ranger, Open Space Division, P&R*

It is believed that staff will be able to beging moving into the new facility at the end of December. The final roofing will be installed in the next couple of weeks, the SDG&E meter was installed today, and the fire sprinkler system installation is scheduled to begin on the 12th of this month.
